
Thank you for ordering your Lourdes veil from the CT Auxiliary.

IMPORTANT: KEEP THE BOX THIS VEIL CAME IN FOR STORAGE AND FOR TRAVELING. HEADBAND CAN BE REMOVED TO TRAVEL WITH IT FLAT.

To care for your veil: spot cleaning is best. Otherwise, remove the headband and hand wash, being careful of the brim and air dry.

For best hold in hair, gather the front of your hair into a barrette or an elastic band before putting on veil (Fig A).


To insert comb start at the approximate place you would like the comb to end up. Now this sounds weird, but works best, next, begin to insert the comb inverted and moving the prongs into the hair towards your forehead (Fig B).

Once the comb has reached beneath the layers of hair to the scalp, rotate the top of the comb and reverse the direction of the movement towards the back of your head (Fig C); keeping the prongs of the comb close to the scalp. This helps the comb to lodge firmly in your hair (Fig D).









Add bobby pins in the loops on the sides if you would like extra anchorage. The crown of the veil will rest on your head like a hat, not pressing on the sides like a headband (Fig E).
